Ongoing wars that the U.S. started years ago have become so commonplace that many Americans barely know they're continuing.

- ★ Repeated provocative actions by the U.S. which threaten a full-blown war with Iran;
- ★ Drone bombings of Yemen, Syria, Somalia, Pakistan, Afghanistan, and Iraq;
- ★ U.S. troops occupying Afghanistan, Iraq, Somalia and Syria;
- ★ Israel's bombings of Syria and Lebanon, and Saudi Arabia's intentional bombings of civilian targets in Yemen;
- ★ Israel's periodic bombings and sniper fire on Palestinians in Gaza, its devastating strangulation of Gaza by a decade-long blockade, the continued thefts of Palestinian land, the official relegation of Palestinian citizens in Israel to 2nd class citizenship;
- ★ Ongoing economic warfare against Iran, Venezuela and Cuba through devastating trade embargoes and sanctions that history shows always hurt ordinary citizens of the targeted countries the most.

This daily U.S. slaughter and oppression of peoples around the world, direct and indirect, all of it intentional and calculated, must end.

All of our hopes for decent treatment of working people in the U.S. – from accessible medical care for all, affordable housing, free education and guaranteed incomes for all, to addressing the climate crisis – are held hostage to a U.S. military budget which is more than the world's next eight largest military budgets combined, including Russia's and China's.
